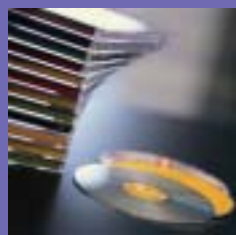

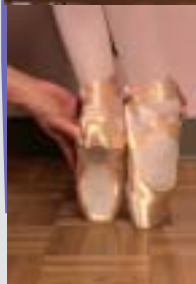

- _____ Artist-creates art work using color, line, form, and mass to express ideas and feelings
- _____ Broadcast Technicians-install, set up, and repair equipment used in TV and radio broadcasts
- _____ Dancer-performs rhythmic and expressive movements to music for entertainment
- _____ Graphic Designer-designs a wide variety of materials to fit the needs of companies

- _____ Stage Technician-installs and operates lights, scenery, and other sound equipment
- _____ Writer-develops fiction and nonfiction prose for books, magazines, journals, etc.
- _____ Publications Editor-formulates policy, plans, and directs editorial activities and supervises workers who select material for various types of publications
- _____ Singer-interprets music using their knowledge of voice production, harmony, and melody to perform individually or with a group for an audience or recording
- _____ Medical Illustrator-draws illustrations of human anatomy and surgical procedures for medical and scientific publications.
