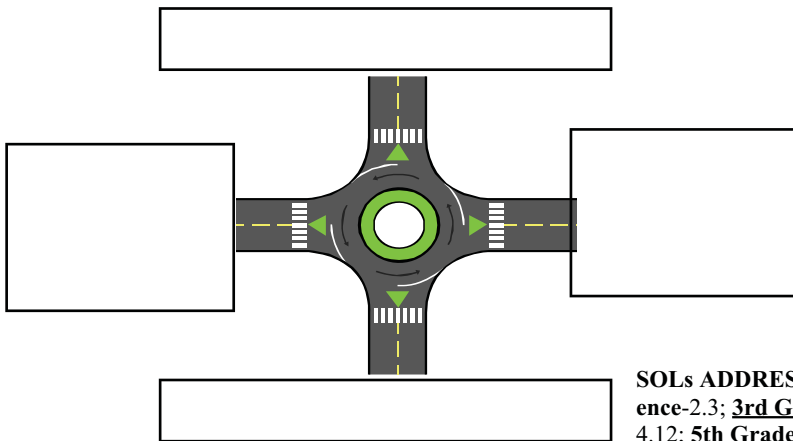


Science & Math Path
