- ◆ **Peace Corps:** A government-based program that combines work and living abroad for 1-2 years. www.peacecorps.gov
- ◆ **Transitions Abroad:** Focuses on working, studying, traveling and living abroad. www.transitionsabroad.com
- ◆ **Study Abroad:** Offers study, work, and volunteer opportunities in different countries. www.studyabroad.com
- ◆ **Global Volunteers:** Non-profit organization that offers volunteer-abroad opportunities. www.globalvolunteers.org
- ◆ **InterExchange:** Discover international exchange programs. www.interexchange.org

Consider Safety:

- ◆ **International Travel Information:** International Travel conditions, alerts and warnings. www.travel.state.gov/
- ◆ **Center for Disease Control and Prevention:** Lists all necessary guidelines and precautions—search by country. www.cdc.gov
